

"I CAN'T BELIEVE the pain is gone. I am so thankful," says a beaming Flo Bisette-Goddard. She was speaking about the Ozone Therapy treatment she has been receiving for the past month.

Living in constant pain for the last two years, sometimes in anguish, Flo was at the state of becoming a recluse as it was taking too much out of her to even move from her bed.

Her condition was so bad she was hospitalised for about five weeks in 2006 and was forced to take medication for the pain since then.

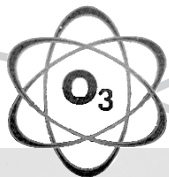

since then and is still amazed at her recovery.

"I am still waiting for the pain to come back," she says in wonderment. "There is no pain now. I really can't believe it has gone," she adds as she gets up and dances around to show how nimble she is.

And what is also good, Flo says, is that she hasn't taken any pain medication since she began treatment at the Ozone Therapy Centres.

"My husband is extremely pleased," she says. "He had to lift me out of the chair and out of bed. My children had to take me where I wanted to go. Now I can move

around on my own.

"I am very impressed. I will be the first person to recommend this treatment to anyone," she adds, although she says she was very sceptical at first. The reason: she had tried many other remedies such as acupuncture and a range of herbal medicines but nothing relieved the pain.

"We call her our miracle lady," says Jan who added that many of their clients have been telling them about the remarkable way they are feeling since undergoing treatment.

Jan, who manages the centre with her husband, Neville, explains that through ozone therapy the body is flooded with oxygen, purifying the water in the body. Toxins are then released from the body through sweat, and bacteria and viruses are killed.
